## Indoor Volleyball Rules

### Recreational 6's

#### Skill levels:

- Recreational – In it for the fun
- Intermediate – Plays at a more skilled level. Everyone comfortable with spiking and overhand serves. Must be 19 or over.

#### RULES

1. All participants must read, sign, and submit the waiver form before playing or the team will forfeit its games.
2. Teams may be comprised of 6 to 10 players. 6 players must be on the court with a minimum of two women. If you only have one woman on the court, you can play with a maximum of 4 players. If a team does not meet the minimum requirement, it will automatically forfeit the game.
3. Each game will stop at the sound of the whistle/horn. Once the end of the game has been announced, do not serve the ball. If the ball is in play at that time, finish the play.
4. Points are awarded on every serve (rally point scoring). There is no cap on points, and a game can end in a tie.
5. Teams will referee their own games and are expected to do so with honesty and a high level of sportsmanship.
6. Serves cannot be blocked or attacked.
7. A block is not counted as a hit.
8. Any part of your body may be used to keep the ball in play.
9. Players may not touch the net at any time during play. A player may cross under the net without violation, as long as he does not touch anyone on the other team, interfere with them playing the ball, or make contact with the net. A player is then allowed to return to his own side and continue the play.
- 10. After five consecutive points, the serving team must rotate to the next server.**
11. Let serves are allowed (the ball can hit the net on the serve, as long as it goes over).
12. Substitute players are allowed in any game prior to the playoffs, with permission from the opposing team. Substitute players are not allowed in playoff games.
13. The score for each game must be reported to the scoring table by the team captains after each game. Game results not reported will be recorded as a tie.  
Game results will be tabulated as follows:  
Win/Default = 2 Points                      Tie = 1 point                      Loss = 0 Points  
When determining playoffs, ties will be broken by the point differential total per team.
14. Common volleyball rules will apply including the items noted above or with the above noted exceptions. Any questions regarding these rules should be directed to the registration/scoring table.
