



Volleyball Tournament Rules

Skill level:

- Recreational – In it for the fun
- Intermediate – Plays regularly at a more skilled level. Everyone comfortable with spiking and overhand servers. Must be 19 or over.

RULES

- All participants must read, sign, and submit the waiver form before playing or your team will be subject to default.
- Teams must be comprised of 6 to 10 players. 6 players can be on the court, minimum of two women. If you only have one woman on the court you can play with a maximum of 4 players. If you have less than 4 players or no women on the court you forfeit your game.
- Serves cannot be blocked or attacked
- Any part of your body may be used to keep the ball in play.
- Points are awarded on every serve (rally point scoring)
- After five consecutive points, the serving team must rotate to the next server
- Each game will stop at the sound of the whistle (around 20 minutes)
- Once the end of the game has been announced, do not serve the ball. If the ball is in play at that time, finish the play.
- The score for each game must be reported to the scoring table by the team captains after each game.
- Game results will be tabulated as follows: Loss = 0 Points Tie = 1 Point Win = 2 Points Default = 2 points
- Teams will referee their own games.
- Stay off the net (if you touch the net while the ball is in play, it's the other teams point)
- A block is not counted as a hit
- Substitute players are allowed in any game prior to the playoffs, with permission from the opposing team
- Let serves are allowed (the ball can hit the net on the serve, as long as it goes over)
- Common volleyball rules will apply including the items noted above or with the above noted exceptions. Any questions regarding these rules should be directed to the registration/scoring registration table.

DISPUTES Please keep in mind that this is a fun tournament for charity and we have tried to keep the rules simple. We ask that you referee your own games. Should a dispute arise, the team captains, and only the team captains, will discuss the situation. If they are unable to quickly agree, replay the point if time permits. You will not be permitted additional playing time because of a dispute.

WAIVERS All participants must sign the waiver form before the start of the first game
